The chamber is happy to report that \$5000 was raised for the "Get Officer Roxie a Partner" fundraiser.



The Christmas tree lighting will immediately follow the Christmas Parade on the east side of the Courthouse. There will be holiday music along with local organizations providing free hot cocoa and selling hot apple cider, coffee, and baked treats.

In addition to all of these activities, A Tiskit A Taskit Antiques & Soda Fountain, located at 71 N Waco Street, will be playing host to Santa Claus from 2pm to 4pm on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> and providing cookies and milk to children who come to visit Santa. 
